These certifications ensure that our production process is structured in an efficient and sustainable manner and is rigorously managed and monitored.

Product Performance

Declarations of Performance (DoP) for all our products are available on our website, in accordance with the EU Construction Products Regulation No. 3110/2024.

In addition, our glazes comply with the chemical resistance requirements of the Australian Standard AS 1976-1992, which is more stringent than the corresponding EN standards.



Water Efficiency

For products intended for the North American market, the company has obtained Water Sense certification (IAPMO), demonstrating compliance with United States water-efficiency regulations.

Product Safety – REACH Declaration

Our ceramic products do not contain any SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) and, being inert materials, do not release any substances over time.

This declaration is made pursuant to Article 33 of EU Regulation 1907/2006 (REACH).

Product Origin

To certify the origin of its ceramic products, the company has obtained a license to use the CERAMICS OF ITALY trademark, established by Confindustria Ceramica, and is also certified ITALYx, a mark that attests to the excellence of Italian manufacturing in conception, design, and production Made in Italy (Certificate No. IT349869 issued by *Bureau Veritas Certification Holding SAS*, valid until 28/02/2028).

Where required, a declaration of preferential origin of goods is issued.
